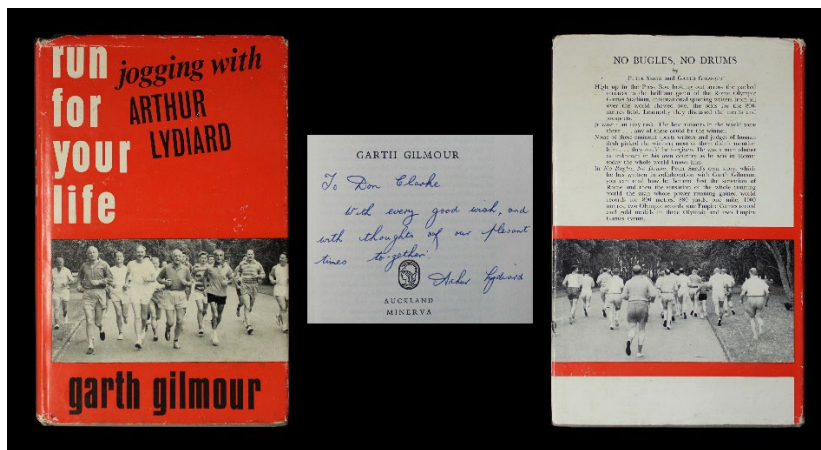

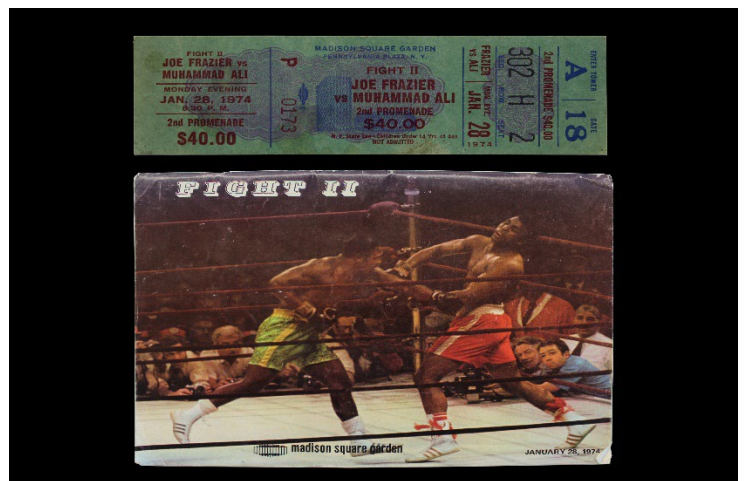

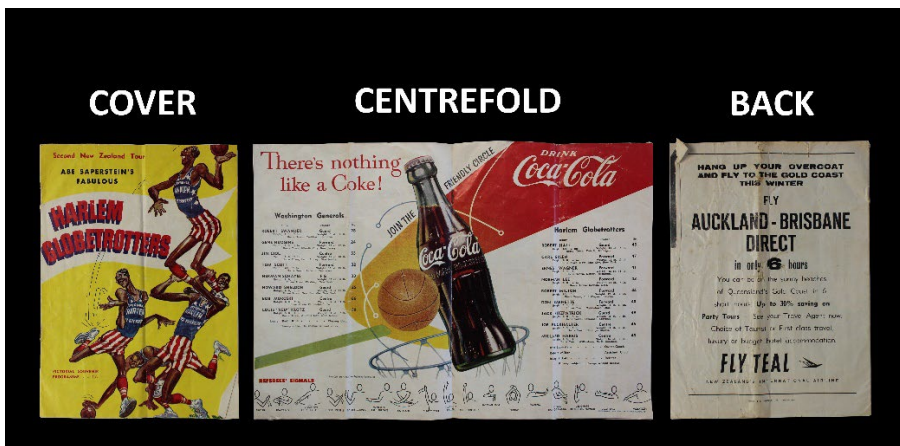

Sir Tennant Edward "Tay" Wilson (3 February 1925 – 26th October 2014)



Lots 9 to 32 are from the collection of Sir Tennant Edward "Tay" Wilson. These reflect his importance in the international Olympic movement with items associated with many of the Games staged between 1980 and 2006 found amongst the lots. They include items from countries lobbying to be awarded rights to stage the Olympics as well as items from the games and associated events. They also illustrate connections at the highest level of the Olympics with towering figures such as Avery Brundage, Juan Antonio Samaranch and New Zealander Sir Lance Cross, and earlier New Zealand International Olympic Committee representative.

Sir Tay Wilson played a large role in New Zealand sport and the Olympic movement. He was an athlete with early success in rowing though interested in many sports, administrator, and true leader. Wilson famously led the four New Zealand athletes attending the 1980 Moscow Olympic games, after 65 nations boycotted the event. They marched under the Olympic rings and fern emblem, not under the New Zealand flag.

At the 1984 Los Angeles Olympics he served as the Chef de Mission of the New Zealand team. From 1985 – 1990 he was Secretary General of the New Zealand Olympic Committee. In 1988, he was elected as the ninth member of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and after his term ended in 2006 served as an honorary member until his death in 2014. Wilson was honored as an Officer of the Order of the British Empire for services to sport in 1989. In August 2009, he accepted redesignation as a Knight Companion of the New Zealand Order of Merit.

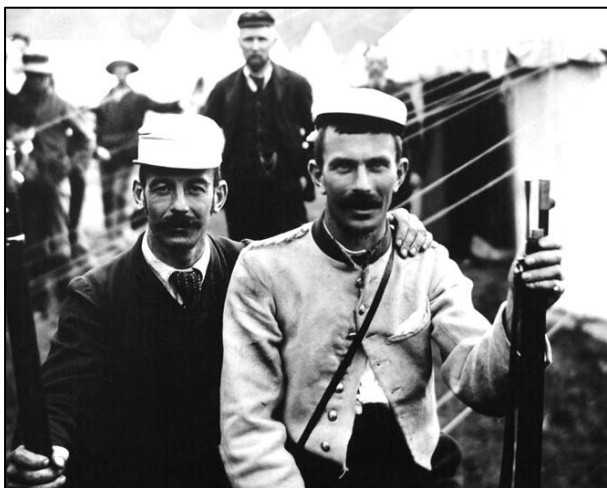

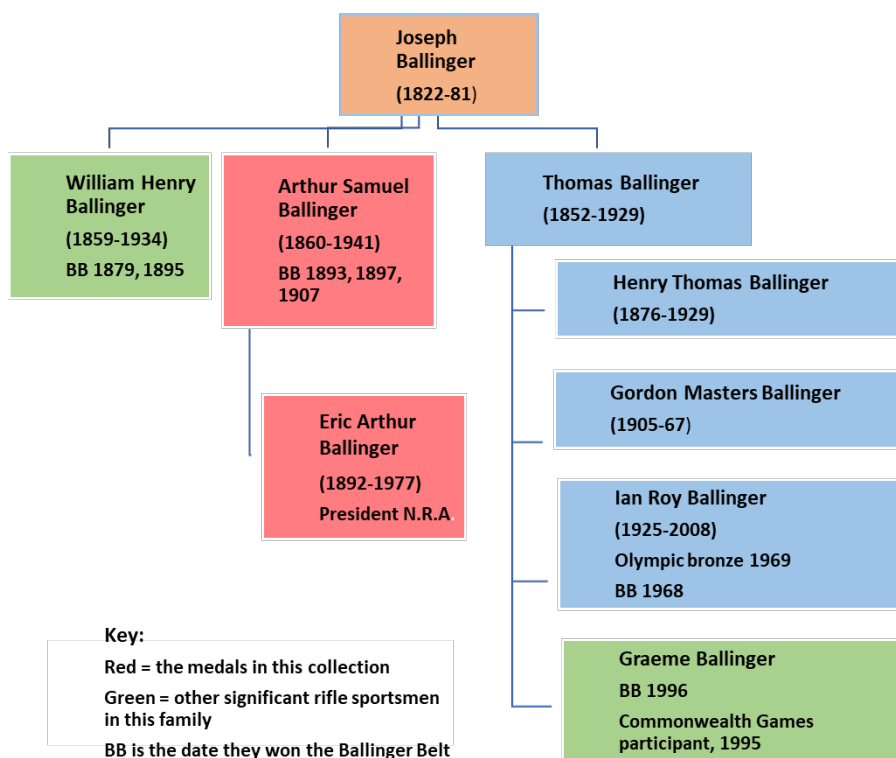
Pictured below: William (Left) & Arthur Ballinger in 1895



Lots 111 to 121 illustrate the outstanding heritage of the Ballinger family in New Zealand shooting, with the most famous trophy, the Ballinger Belt being named after Arthur Ballinger. The auction includes trophies and medals won by Arthur and other family members. Stories about the competitions in New Zealand and abroad at which these awards were won are retold with each of the important lots included in this catalogue.

Ballinger is the most famous name in New Zealand shooting. The following medals either bear that name or were awarded to a member of the Ballinger family. Spanning over one hundred years. The collection was consigned to Mowbray Collectables by descendants of the family.

The Ballinger family has raised many of New Zealand's top shooters. Ian Ballinger won New Zealand's first ever Olympic medal for shooting - a bronze medal at the 1968 Mexico City Olympics. The Ballingers were prominent in the creation of the Petone Rifle Club, and staunch supporters of the Volunteer forces. The Ballinger Belt is presented at the annual shooting competition to find the "NZ Champion Shot". Its history starts with Arthur Ballinger, who, after his third victory at the competition (1893, 97, & 1907) was entitled to retain the 'Champion Belt' but instead donated it to the National Rifle Association. Online bids can be placed via our bidding platform auctions.mowbraycollectables.com or Apps until the auction closes, or alternatively if needed through us by mail, phone, fax, or email and we will place them through Auction Mobility on your behalf. Such non-live online bids should be received in our office no later than 8am Tuesday 29 November (GMT + 13 hours) (at your risk if not received by the auctioneer in time). Telephone bidding is not available.

Bids are best placed directly online. If unclear about how to bid or facing slow internet connections and keen to win, please place your maximum bid before the auction closes.

Posting bids by mail is available but not recommended as postal systems are slow please allow at least one week in New Zealand and longer from overseas, and advise the lot number, your maximum bid, email, phone and address details. Bids will be placed at one bidding increment above the reserve or next highest bidder up to your maximum bid.

For this auction, no surcharge applies for bidding through Auction Mobility.

How Timed Auction Bidding Works

1. Register to bid online at auctions.mowbraycollectables.com
2. Download the Mowbray Collectables app if needed for mobile phone bidding
3. Place your maximum bid online. Your bid will be placed at one increment above the next highest bid. (eg if you bid \$200 and someone else has bid \$100, your bid will be placed at \$110 and rise to your maximum bid only if other parties bid again.) You will be notified by email if you are not online and are outbid and but will get notice within your bidding App if you are online (We cannot provide that notification if you do not register directly to bid online and register your email address.)
- 4. Lots will close sequentially from 7 pm New Zealand standard time on 29 November 2022 at one-minute intervals. Lots will auto extend if bids are placed in the last 5 minutes of the auction of each lot by a further 5 minutes to allow other bidders to respond. The bidding Apps will show how many minutes remain until the closing time for each lot.**
5. The online bidding Apps on your phone or computer allow you to choose how lots are displayed – whether by price, time to close or in lot order or lots you have marked as watched lots. You can change that display order so that you can see which lots are closing first, given that some lots may auto-extend, so that you can better keep track of all lots you particularly want to buy. It pays to refresh the display on the App regularly so that you can keep track of bidding on all lots approaching their closing time.
6. You will be notified by email if successful and invoiced for your purchases, including freight amounts, unless you choose to pick up lots from our Otaki premises directly.
